Rightly Dividing the Word of Truth

Interpreting the More Sure Word

- **Faithful Christians mark and avoid all heretics.**
- **“More sure” is only as good as interpretation.**
- **We must follow rules of study to interpret rightly.**
- **We rightly divide words for the sense (II Tim 2:15).**
- **We want the sense, not sound, of words (Neh 8:8).**

We Must Interpret Soberly

- **If we are foolish or hasty, heresies will result.**
- **The same word in different places means little.**
- **Words may have one, two, three, or more senses.**
- **“Board” ... wood, pins, food, direct, ship, games...**
- **“Saved,” a very key word, has 5 senses and more.**

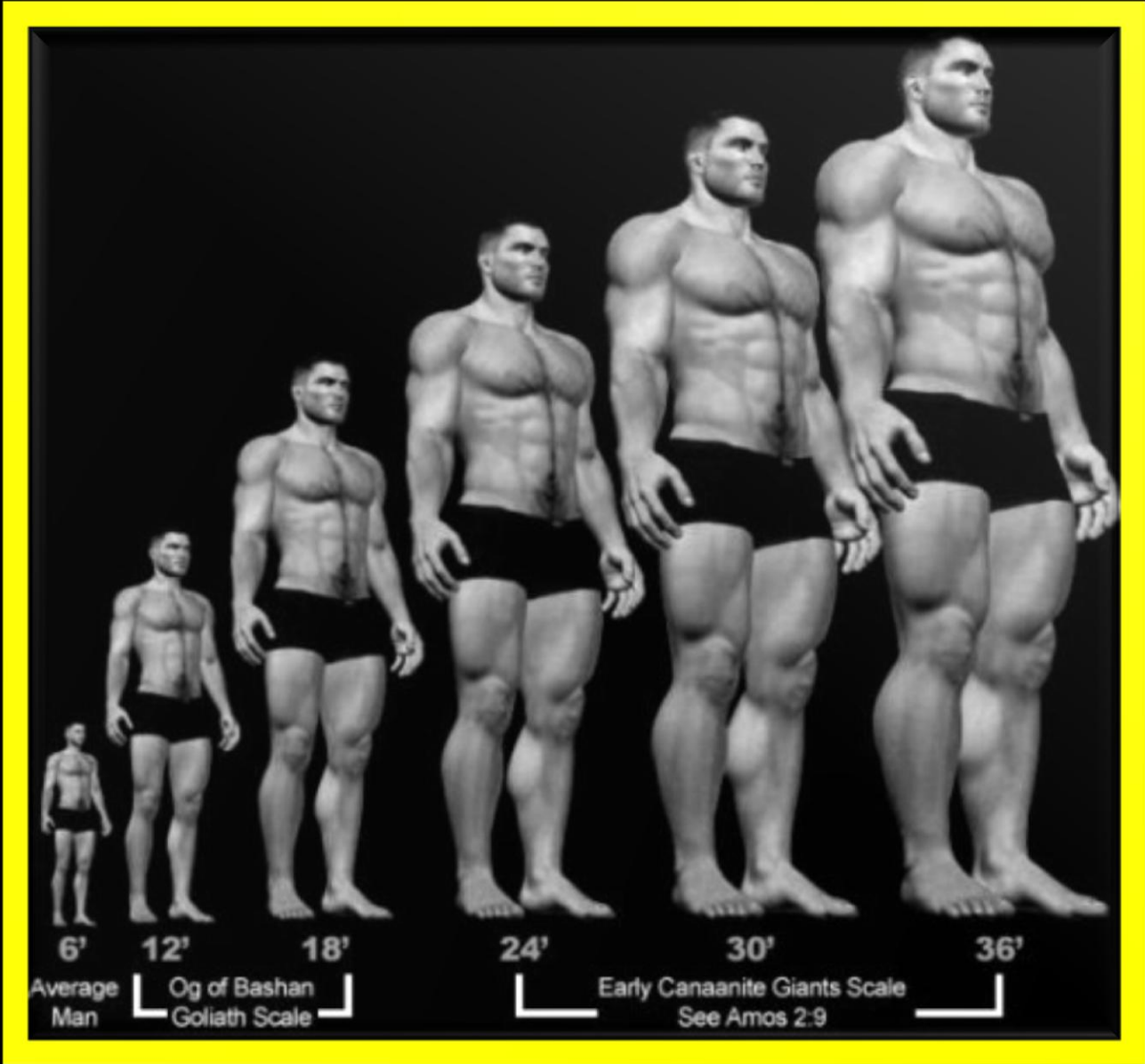

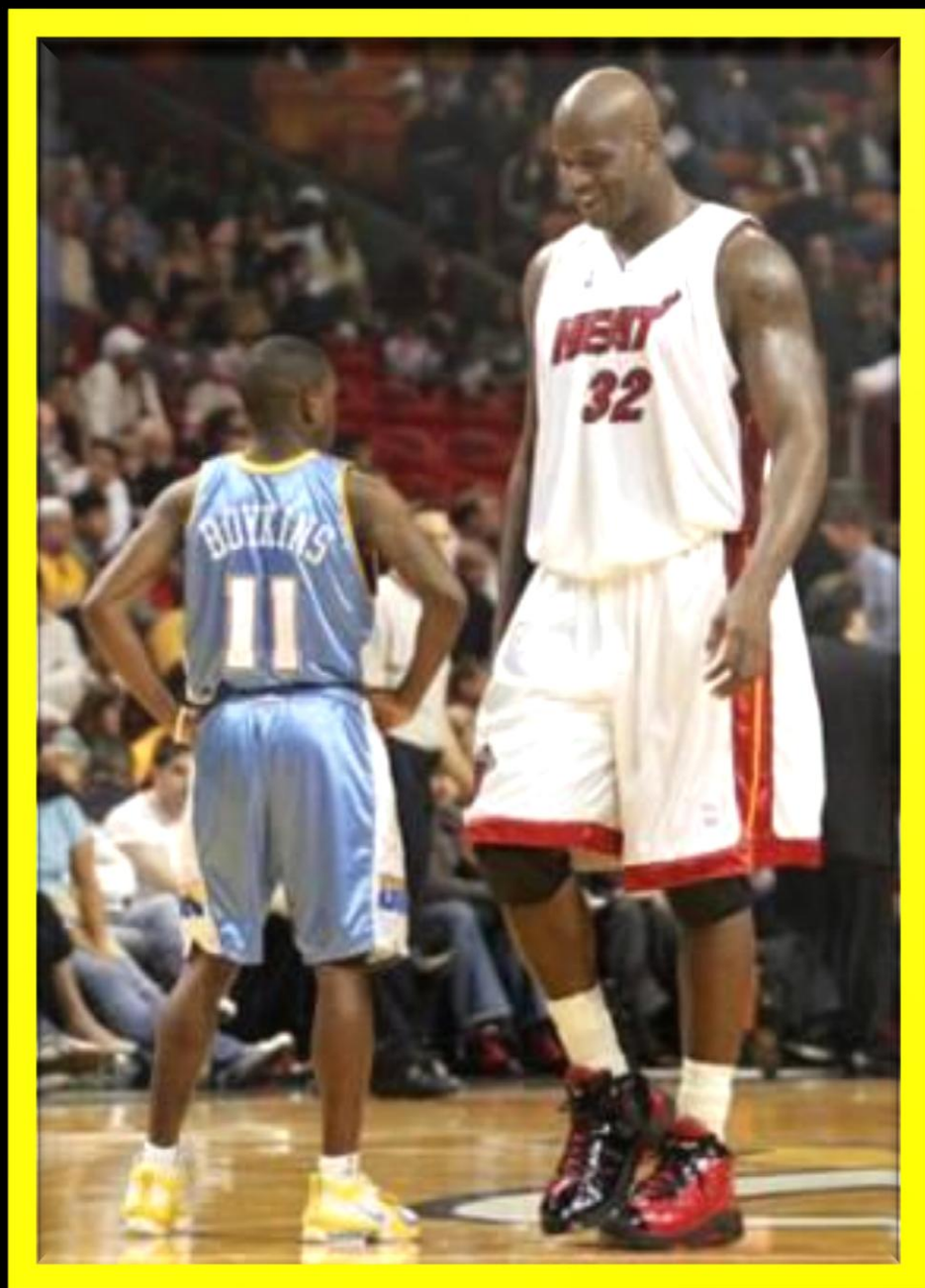

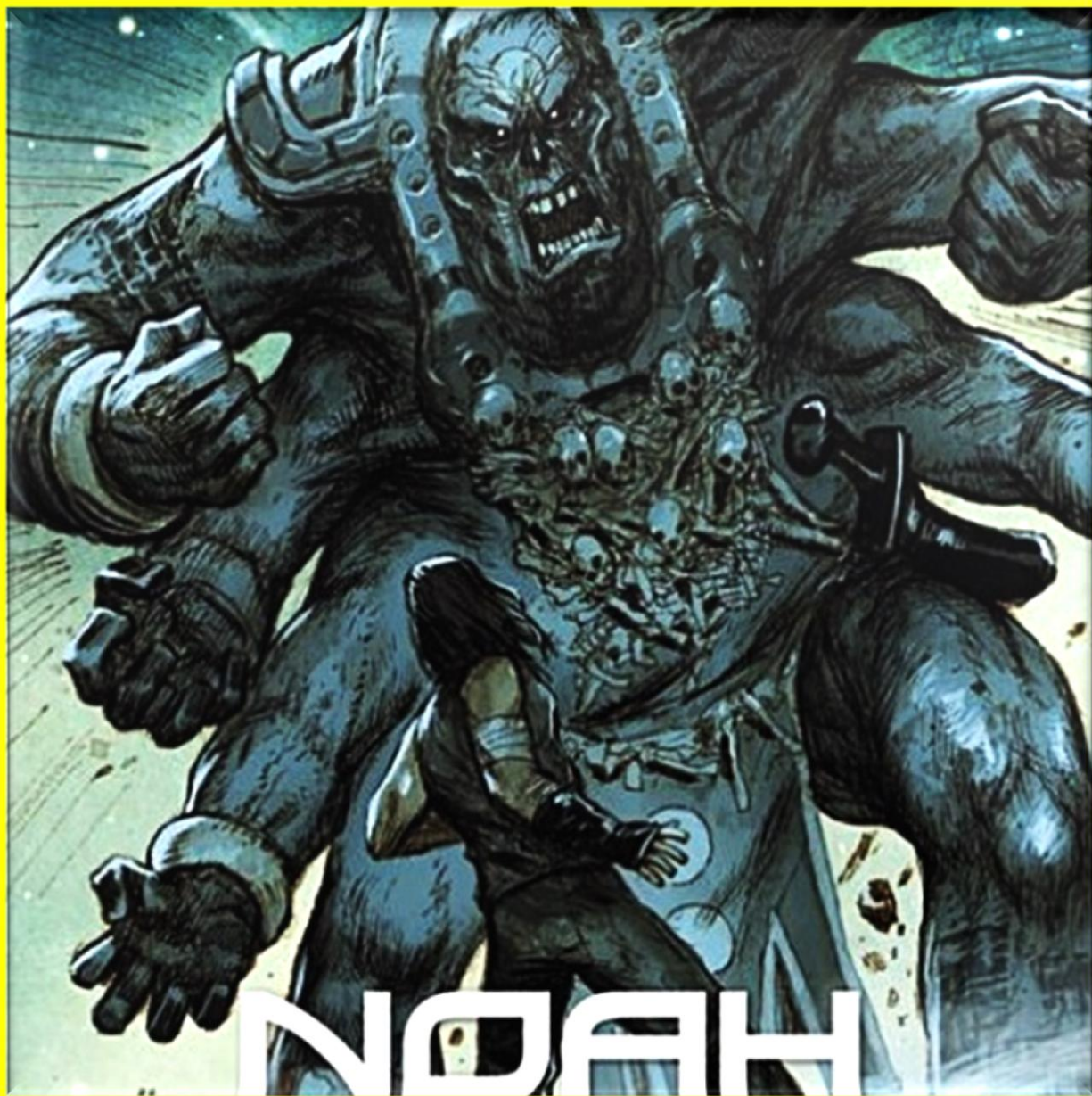












There Are No Nephilim !!!!
