- Malachi 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in Mine house, and prove Me now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of Heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

- **Luke 6:38** Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

- **Psalms 119:130** The entrance of Thy Words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.
- **Psalms 143:8b** Cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto Thee.
- **Proverbs 3:6** In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.
- **Proverbs 15:22** Without counsel purposes are disappointed: but in the multitude of counsellors they are established.
- **Isaiah 30:21** Thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

- **Luke 22:42** Father, if Thou be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Thine, be done.
- Romans 12:1,2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in Heaven give good things to them that ask Him?
- **Romans 8:32** He that spared not His Own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?
- **Philippians 4:19** My God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Trials, Temptations, and Tribulations

- **Job 23:10** He knoweth the way that I take: when He hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.
- **Proverbs 1:10** My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.
- **Proverbs 3:11,12** My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord; neither be weary of His correction: For whom the Lord loveth He correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.
- **Matthew 26:41** Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.
- 1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, Who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.
- **2 Timothy 2:3** Endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.

- Hebrews 12:2,3 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him that endured such contradiction of sinners against Himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.
- **James 1:3** The trying of your faith worketh patience.
- **James 1:12** Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love Him.
- 1 Peter 1:7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ.
- **2 Peter 2:9a** The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations.

Suffering

- **Psalms 34:19** Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all.
- **Psalms 119:67** Before I was afflicted I went astray: but now have I kept Thy Word.
- **Psalms 119:71** It is good for me that I have been afflicted; that I might learn Thy statutes.
- **Romans 8:18** For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.
- **Romans 8:28** And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose.
- **2 Corinthians 4:17** For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.
- **2 Timothy 2:12** If we suffer, we shall also reign with Him: if we deny Him, He also will deny us.

1 Peter 4:19 Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to Him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator.

Comfort

- **Psalms 23:4** Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for Thou art with me; Thy rod and Thy staff they comfort me.
- **Psalms 30:5** For His anger endureth but a moment; in His favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.
- **Psalms 119:50** This is my comfort in my affliction: for Thy Word hath quickened me.
- **Psalms 145:14** The Lord upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down.
- **Psalms 147:3** He healeth up the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.
- **Isaiah 54:7** For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee.
- **Lamentations 3:32,33** Though He cause grief, yet will He have compassion according to the multitude of His mercies. For He doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men.

- **Matthew 5:4** Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
- **John 14:1** Let not your heart be troubled: Ye believe in God, believe also in Me.
- **John 14:18** I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.
- **2 Corinthians 1:4** Who comforteth us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of God.
- **Hebrews 4:16** Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.
- **Hebrews 13:5b** He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.
- **1 Peter 5:7** Casting all your care upon Him; for He careth for you.
- **Revelation 21:4** God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Healing.

- 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds. Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.

Ephesians 4:27 Neither give place to the devil. **Ephesians 6:11,12** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- **Ephesians 6:16** Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
- **James 4:7b** Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- 1 Peter 5:8,9a Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: whom resist stedfast in the faith.
- **1 John 2:14b** The Word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one.
- **1 John 3:8b** For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.
- **1 John 4:4b** Greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world.

Fear Not.

- **Psalms 27:1** The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
- **Psalms 34:4** I sought the Lord, and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.
- **Psalms 56:3** What time I am afraid, I will trust in Thee.
- **Psalms 56:11** In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.
- **Psalms 118:6** The Lord is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?
- **Proverbs 29:25** The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the Lord shall be safe.
- **Isaiah 12:2a** Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid.
- **Isaiah 26:3** Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on Thee: because he trusteth in Thee.
- **Isaiah 41:10** Fear thou not; for I am with thee: Be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I

- will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness.
- **John 14:27** Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.
- **2 Timothy 1:7** God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

- **Psalms 107:8** Oh that men would praise the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men!
- 1 Corinthians 10:10 Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer.
- **Philippians 2:14** Do all things without murmurings and disputings.
- **Philippians 4:11** I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, therewith to be content.
- **1Thessalonians 5:18** In every thing give thanks.

Pride, Self-Righteousness and Humility_____

- **Proverbs 11:2** When pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly is wisdom.
- **Proverbs 16:18** Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
- **Daniel 4:37b** Those that walk in pride He is able to abase.
- **Matthew 23:12** Whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.
- **Luke 6:41,42b** Why beholdest thou the mote that is in thy brother's eye, but perceivest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.
- **2 Corinthians 10:17** He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.
- **Philippians 2:3** Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

1 Peter 5:5b,6 All of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble. Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time.

- **Psalms 19:14** Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in Thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer.
- **Psalms 35:28** My tongue shall speak of Thy righteousness and of Thy praise all the day long.
- **Proverbs 16:24** Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.
- **Proverbs 17:27** He that hath knowledge spareth his words: and a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit.
- **Proverbs 18:21a** Death and life are in the power of the tongue.
- **Proverbs 29:11** A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.
- **Matthew 12:34b** Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.

And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.
- **Amos 3:3** Can two walk together, except they be agreed?
- **Romans 12:5** We, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.
- **Romans 14:19** Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.
- **Romans 16:17** Mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.

- 1 Corinthians 1:10 Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

- **Romans 12:2** Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
- **2 Corinthians 6:14** Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion hath light with darkness?
- **2 Corinthians 6:17** Come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord,

- and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

Matthew 5:10-12 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven. Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in Heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

Matthew 10:23a When they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another.

John 15:18 If the world hate you, ye know that it hated Me before it hated you.

John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his Lord. If they have persecuted Me, they will also persecute you.

John 16:2b The time cometh, that whosoever killeth you will think that he doeth God service.

Philippians 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on Him, but also to suffer for His sake.

2 Timothy 3:12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

Backsliding

Psalms 37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide.

Proverbs 13:15b The way of transgressors is hard.

Proverbs 14:14a The backslider in heart shall be filled with his own ways.

2 Timothy 4:10a Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world.

Hebrews 10:38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, My soul shall have no pleasure in him.

Hebrews 11:15 If they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.

2 Peter 2:20-22 For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than,

after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire.

Christianity in Crisis.

- **Ezekiel 33:31** They come unto thee as the people cometh, and they sit before thee as My people, and they hear thy words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they show much love, but their heart goeth after their covetousness.
- **Ezekiel 34:2b,3** Woe be to the shepherds of Israel that do feed themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flocks? Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: but ye feed not the flock
- **Matthew 15:8,9** This people draweth nigh unto Me with their mouth, and honoureth Me with their lips; but their heart is far from Me. In vain they do worship Me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.
- **Matthew 22:29** Ye do err, not knowing the Scriptures, nor the power of God.
- Mark 7:9,13 Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition. Making the Word of God of none

- effect through your tradition, which ye have delivered.
- **Acts 7:48** Howbeit the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet.
- **2 Timothy 3:5** Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.
- **Revelation 3:15,16** I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot. So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of My mouth.

(See Matthew 23—Jesus' rebuke to the scribes and Pharisees.)

The Law of Christ

Matthew 22:37-40 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it. Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

- **John 1:17** For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.
- **Romans 3:28** Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.
- **Romans 8:2** The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- **Romans 10:4** For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that believeth.
- **Romans 13:8b** He that loveth another hath fulfilled the law.
- **Galatians 2:21** I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law,

then Christ is dead in vain.

- **Galatians 3:13a** Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law.
- **Galatians 3:24,25** The law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.
- **Galatians 5:1** Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- **Galatians 5:13** For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.
- **Galatians 5:14** For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- **1 Timothy 1:9a** Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient.
- **James 2:10** Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.

Creation vs. Evolution

- **Genesis 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- **Acts 14:15b** Ye should turn from these vanities unto the living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein.
- **Romans 1:20-22,25** For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, Who is blessed for ever.
- **1 Timothy 6:20** Keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and

- vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called.
- **2 Timothy 3:7** Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.
- **Hebrews 11:3** Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

The "Time of the End"_

Signs of Christ's Second Coming:

Matthew 24:3 And as He sat upon the Mount of Olives, the disciples came unto Him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be and what shall be the sign of Thy coming, and of the end of the world?

Matthew 24:5-7 Many shall come in My name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

Matthew 24:12,14 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. And this gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and *then* shall the end come.

Daniel 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

(See also Matthew 16:3b; 1 Thessalonians 5:1-8; 2 Timothy 3:1-7; 2 Peter 3:3-5.)

The Antichrist and His World Government:

Daniel 8:23 And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.

Daniel 9:27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week (7 years): And in the midst of the week (after 3-1/2 years) he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspread-

ing of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

Daniel 11:21 (*There*) shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the kingdom: but he shall come in peaceably, and obtain the kingdom by flatteries.

Daniel 11:23-24 And after the league made with him he shall work deceitfully: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people. He shall enter peaceably even upon the fattest places of the province; and he shall do that which his fathers have not done, nor his fathers' fathers; he shall scatter among them the prey, and spoil, and riches: yea, and he shall forecast his devices against the strong holds, even for a time.

Daniel 11:31 And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate. (See also

Daniel 8:11,12; 11:45.)

2 Thessalonians 2:4 (*The son of perdition*) opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

Revelation 13:3b, 4 And all the world wondered after the beast. And they worshipped the dragon (the Devil) which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? Who is able to make war with him?

The "Great Tribulation":

Matthew 24:15, 21 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, whoso readeth, let him understand: For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. (See also Daniel 11:31; 12:1.)

Revelation 13:5,7 And there was given unto him (*the antichrist*) a mouth speaking great

things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months. And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: And power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

Revelation 13:15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

Revelation 13:16,17 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

Revelation 13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six. (666!)

Daniel 7:25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out

the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: And they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time. (See also Daniel 11:32-35; Revelation 12:6-17.)

The Resurrection and Rapture of the Saved:

Matthew 24:29-31 Immediately after the tribulation of those days...shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: And then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together His elect.

1 Thessalonians 4:16,17 For the Lord
Himself shall descend from Heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: And the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: And so shall we ever be

with the Lord.

1 Corinthians 15:51,52 Behold, I show you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

(See also 1 John 3:2; Philippians 3:21.)

The Judgement Seat of Christ:

2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

Daniel 12:2,3 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

The Battle of Armageddon:

Revelation 19:11,14 And I saw Heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war. And the armies which were in Heaven followed Him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Revelation 19:19-21 And I saw the beast. and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him that sat on the horse, and against His army. And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone. And the remnant were slain. with the sword of Him that sat upon the horse. (See also Revelation 16:12-17: 17:12-14.)

The Millennium:

Daniel 2:44 And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.

Revelation 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: And I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Isaiah 11:6,9 The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.

The Great White Throne Judgement:

Revelation 20:11,12 And I saw a great white throne, and Him that sat on it, from Whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: And another book was opened, which is the book of life: And the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

The New Heaven and New Earth:

Revelation 21:1-4 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from

God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of Heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people, and God Himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

Revelation 21:16 And the city lieth four-square, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs (1,500 miles or 2,400 kms). The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

Revelation 21:24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it.
