The Promise of answered requests

“Ask and it **will** be given to you” (Matt. 7.7)

“Seek and you **will** find” (Matt. 7.7)

“Knock and the door **will** be opened to you” (Matt. 7.7)

“I **will** do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father” (Jn. 14.13)

“You may ask me for anything in my name, and I **will** do it” (Jn. 14.14)

“If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it **will** be given to you” (Jn. 15.7)

“My Father **will** give you whatever you ask in my name” (Jn. 16.23)

“Ask and you **will** receive, and your joy **will** be complete” (Jn. 16.24)

The Promise of the fruit of faith and belief

“If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, ‘move from here to there’ and it **will** move. Nothing will be impossible for you” (Matt. 17.20-21)

“If two of you on earth agree about anything you ask for, it **will** be done for you by my Father in heaven” (Matt 18.19)

“If you have faith and do not doubt, not only can you do what was done to this fig tree, but also you can say to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and it **will** be done. If you believe, you **will** receive whatever you ask for in prayer” (Matt. 21.21.22)

“**Everything** is possible for him who believes” (Mk. 9.23)

“Whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it **will** be yours” (Mk. 11.24)

“Anyone who has faith in me **will** do what I have been doing. He **will** do even greater things than these” (Jn. 14.12)

The Promise of salvation and eternal life

“If anyone keeps my word, he will **never** see death” (Jn. 8.51)

“Everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or fields for my sake **will** receive a hundred times as much and **will** inherit eternal life” (Matt. 19.29)

“He who stands firm to the end **will** be saved” (“Matt. 24.13)

“Whoever believes and is baptised **will** be saved” (Mk. 15.16)

“Whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me **will save** it” (Lk. 9.24)

“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son that whoever believes in him shall not perish but **have** eternal life” (Jn. 3.16)

“Whoever believes in him [God’s Son] is **not** condemned” (Jn. 3.18)

“Whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me **has** eternal life and will not be condemned; he **has** crossed over from death to life” (Jn. 5.24)

“My Father’s will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall **have** eternal life, and I **will** raise him up at the last day” (Jn. 6.40)

“I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he **will** live forever” (Jn. 6.51)

“Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood **has** eternal life, and I **will** raise him up at the last day” (Jn. 6.54)

“Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me **will** live because of me” (Jn. 6.57)

“I am the gate; whoever enters through me **will** be saved” (Jn. 10.9)

“I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me **will** live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will **never** die” (Jn. 11.25)

The Promise of friendship and union with Jesus

“Where two or three come together in my name, there am I **with** them” (Matt 18.20)

“Whoever acknowledges me before men, I **will** also acknowledge him before my father in heaven” (Matt. 10.32)

“**Surely** I am with you always, to the very end of the age” (Matt. 28.20)

“Whoever comes to me I will **never** drive away” (Jn. 6.37)

“**Everyone** who listens to the Father and learns from him comes to me” (Jn. 6.45)

“**Whoever** eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him” (Jn. 6.56)

“I am the light of the world. **Whoever** follows me will never walk in darkness, but **will** have the light of life” (Jn. 8.12)

“Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am my servant will also be. My Father **will** honour the one who serves me” (Jn. 12.26)

“I, when I am lifted up from the earth **will** draw all men to myself” (Jn. 12.32)

“I will not leave you as orphans; I **will** come to you” (Jn. 14.18)

“If a man remains in me and I in him, he **will** bear much fruit” (Jn. 15.5)

“You **are** my friends if you do what I command” (Jn. 15.14)

The Promise of God’s blessings

“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs **is** the kingdom of heaven” (Matt 5.3)

“Blessed are those who mourn, for they **will** be comforted” (Matt 5.4)

“Blessed are the meek, for they **will** inherit the earth” (Matt 5.5)

“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they **will** be filled” (Matt 5.6)

“Blessed are the merciful, for they **will** be shown mercy” (Matt 5.7)

"I **will** give you words and wisdom that none of your adversaries will be able to resist or contradict" (Lk. 22.15)

"If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. Then you **will** know the truth, and the truth **will** set you free" (Jn. 8.31-32)

"If the Son sets you free, you **will** be free indeed" (Jn. 8.36)

"You **are** already clean because of the word I have spoken to you" (Jn. 15.3)

"If you forgive anyone his sins, they **are** forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven" (Jn. 20.23)

The Promise of the Spirit

"When they arrest you, do not worry about what to say or how to say it. At that time you **will** be given what to say, for it will not be you speaking, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you" (Matt. 10.19-20)

"When he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he **will** guide you into all the truth" (Jn. 16.13)

"Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water **will** flow from within him" (Jn. 7.38)
